Internships Available

Reproduction, ultra sounding, collecting stallions, processing cooled semen, Embryo Transfer, utilizing Frozen semen, foaling, Basic husbandry, Farming Hay, Straw and other crops, Nutrition, field management

We at Southwind farms are now opening our doors to students that would like to participate in our internship programs. We are a large scale, equine reproduction facility that can offer a lot of hands on experience in the reproduction and farm management fields.

What we are looking for:

January through June: There are three shifts available and they will be "rotating" shifts to ensure each student gets to participate in all farm activities. Two foaling shifts "night shifts" and a day shift. We will go over our foaling protocol with you and based on your experience we will guide you through the first few foalings. Our foaling protocol is very intensive, colostrums testing, igg, 12 hours post foaling rhodococcus transfusion ect. This will all be hands on.

The day shift will include, ultra sounding mares, collecting stallions and processing semen in a real-time breeding environment, utilizing state of the art equipment and computer programs. Breeding, culturing, treating mares. Treating and Diagnosing illness "on farm". Embryo transfer and synchronization of estrus cycles.

For the above season we would like 8+week internships.

June through November: There will be two shifts available both will be during the day, One shift will start earlier than the other, approx, 4am. The 2nd shift will start at 8am.

Through this time you will catch the tail end of our breeding season and you will still be able to participate in many of the breeding activities, however we will be completed foaling. We start freezing semen from our stallions for overseas around the end of July. Yearlings prepping, weaning occurs at this time.

From June until November we are able to take students that require less that 8 weeks of internships

We do not offer any salary or housing. Most students, Buddy up with other students to rent an apartment nearby, stay with relatives, or commute. All School insurance must be presented prior to signing up with us and a injury liability waiver needs to be signed. We can only take 3-4 internships at any given time, please contact us ASAP if you are interested in our 2012 program for it is already filling up since our announcement last week.
